Mandan. The event is scheduled to be held on

Touch A Truck offers children an up-close, hands-on opportunity to explore heavy machinery, safety vehicles, and other cool trucks, as well as ask questions of the people who operate these machines.

We will be closing off six blocks on Main Street in Mandan to bring in the equipment and hold the event. Admission to Touch A Truck is free, but attendees will be asked to bring a non-perishable food item. All of these donated goods will then be given to the Aid Incorporated Food Pantry.

This year we are also adding a job fair to our Touch a Truck event. Participants will get the chance to reach out into the community with employment options. All Touch a Truck sponsors will be allowed to set up a job fair tent free of charge.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

- 1. BRING A TRUCK OR TWO:** We are seeking companies interested in bringing equipment and an operator to the event. Equipment operators are responsible for all transport of equipment and are required to be with the equipment during the event for safety purposes and to answer questions.
